Subject: Preliminary LAFCO FY 2020/2021 Budget

Background

LAFCO is required to hold two public hearings prior to adoption of the LAFCO Budget. Historically, the LAFCO Executive Officer has provided a Preliminary LAFCO budget to the Commission in March and requests that the LAFCO Commission set budget hearings for regular meetings in April and May. State law requires that the LAFCO Budget be adopted by the end of May each year.

The Preliminary LAFCO FY Budget for 2020/2021 Budget is provided, but may have a few minor modifications as some Kings County associated costs are still being factored in. The overall budget, however, will be very close to this preliminary estimate. This budget will represent an increase from last year.

Recommend

The Executive Officer recommends that the LAFCO Commission set the first Public Hearing for the LAFCO FY 2020/2021 Budget on April 22, 2020 and direct staff to send notice to the county and each city.
