NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a public hearing will be held by the Local Agency Formation Commission of Kings County to consider the proposed:

1. LAFCO Case No. 05-13 - City of Corcoran Reorganization No. 2005-A

Consisting of the annexation of one unincorporated "island" and three "substantially surrounded" areas to the City of Corcoran and detachment from the Kings River Conservation District and Tulare Lake Resource Conservation District. Combined territory totals approximately 278.1 acres. The island area is located west of Otis Avenue, north of North Avenue, east of Dairy Avenue and south of Crown Road. Area 1 is located south of Orange Avenue and east of 7th Avenue. Area 2 is located east of 7th Avenue, north of Sherman Avenue and south of North Avenue. Area 3 is located east of Dairy Avenue, north of Ottawa Avenue and south of Oregon Avenue. Properties are in Section 11, 14, 15 and 23 of Township 21 South, Range 22 East, M.D.B. & M.

2. LAFCO Case No. 05-15 - City of Hanford Reorganization No. 135

Consisting of the annexation to the City of Hanford and detachment from the Kings River Conservation District and Excelsior-Kings River Resource Conservation District of approximately 443.34 acres. Generally located north of Houston Avenue along the west and east sides of 12th Avenue. Properties are in Section 2 and 3 of Township 19 South, Range 21 East, M.D.B. & M.

Said hearing will be held at 3:00 p.m. or as soon thereafter as possible, on Wednesday, December 7, 2005, in the Board of Supervisors Chambers, Administration Building, Kings County Government Center, 1400 W. Lacey Boulevard, Hanford, California.

At the hearing, the Commission will consider oral and written testimony by any interested person or affected agency and the report of the Executive Officer. In compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act, each City has adopted an initial study/negative declaration for their respective project. LAFCO as a "Responsible Agency" will consider the City initial study/negative declaration before any action is taken.
