NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Local Agency Formation Commission Of Kings County will hold a public hearing to consider the proposed:

LAFCO Case No. 05-12, Hanford Reorganization No. 133

An annexation of 162.73 acres to the City of Hanford, and detachment of the same from the Kings River Conservation District and Excelsior-Kings River Resource Conservation District.

The territory proposed for detachment is generally described as follows:

The Northeast quarter of Section 27, Township 18 South, Range 21 East, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian. Territory consists of five properties located immediately south of Grangeville Blvd. and west of 12th Ave.

Said hearing will be held at 3:30 p.m. or as soon thereafter as possible, on Wednesday, January 25, 2006, in the Board of Supervisors Chambers, Administration Building, Kings County Government Center, 1400 W. Lacey Boulevard, Hanford, California.

At the hearing, the Commission will consider oral and written testimony by any interested person or affected agency and the report of the Executive Officer. In compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act, the City of Hanford prepared an initial study/negative declaration for proposed annexation. As a Responsible Agency, LAFCO will consider the initial study/negative declaration before any action is taken.
