## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a public hearing will be held by the Local Agency Formation Commission of Kings County to consider the proposed:

**1. LAFCO Case No. 06-06 - City of Hanford Reorganization No. 131**

Consisting of two areas totaling 81.88 acres proposed for annexation to the City of Hanford and detachment from the Kings River Conservation District and Excelsior-Kings River Resource Conservation District. Area 1 is generally located southeast of Grangeville Blvd. and Beulah St. Area 2 is generally located south of Grangeville Blvd and east of 13<sup>th</sup> Ave.

**2. LAFCO Case No. 06-07 - City of Hanford Reorganization No. 132**

Consisting of two areas totaling 11.71 acres proposed for annexation to the City of Hanford and detachment from the Kings River Conservation District and Excelsior-Kings River Resource Conservation District. Area 1 is generally located south of Flint Avenue and west of Highway 43. Area 2 is generally located along the north and south sides of Fargo Avenue and west of the B.N. & S.F. Railroad.

Said hearing will be held at 3:30 p.m. or as soon thereafter as possible, on Wednesday, October 25, 2006, in the Board of Supervisors Chambers, Administration Building, Kings County Government Center, 1400 W. Lacey Boulevard, Hanford, California.

At the hearing, the Commission will consider oral and written testimony by any interested person or affected agency and the report of the Executive Officer. In compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act, the City has adopted an initial study/negative declaration for their project. LAFCO as a "Responsible Agency" will consider the City initial study/negative declaration before any action is taken. For LAFCO Case No. 06-06, the Commission may consider waiver of any Protest Proceedings if no opposition has been presented by the close of the public hearing from either a property owner owning land within or registered voter residing within the subject territory.
