NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING TO RECEIVE PROTEST AGAINST PROPOSAL

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a protest hearing will be held by the Local Agency Formation Commission of Kings County to receive protest against the proposed:

1. LAFCO Case No. 06-07 - City of Hanford Reorganization No. 132

Consisting of two areas totaling 11.71 acres proposed for annexation to the City of Hanford and detachment from the Kings River Conservation District and Excelsior-Kings River Resource Conservation District. Area 1 is generally located south of Flint Avenue and west of Highway 43. Area 2 is generally located along the north and south sides of Fargo Avenue and west of the B.N. & S.F. Railroad.

The City of Hanford initiated the annexation and detachment, by applying to the Local Agency Formation Commission of Kings County (LAFCO) for approval. LAFCO approved the reorganization proposal on October 25, 2006, subject to the terms and conditions stated in LAFCO Resolution No. 06-11, which is available for review at the LAFCO Office.

Said hearing will be held at 3:30 p.m. or as soon thereafter as possible, on Wednesday, December 6, 2006, in the Board of Supervisors Chambers, Administration Building, Kings County Government Center, 1400 W. Lacey Boulevard, Hanford, California.

Written protests against this detachment may be filed by owners of land within the area. Protests may either be mailed to LAFCO of Kings County, 1400 W. Lacey Blvd, Hanford, CA 93230 by 9 a.m. the day of the hearing or delivered to the Executive Officer of the Local Agency Formation Commission at the protest hearing. Each protest must include the name and address of the protestor and a street address or parcel number identifying the location of the land. Each written protest must be filed no later than the conclusion of the hearing to be considered valid.

The effect of protests received will be determined at the hearing in accordance with Government Code Section 57075. For more information, please call (559) 582-3211 ext. 2670.
